BADEN SUBSIDIARY AWARDED SALES CONTRACTS

Richard Ball, Chairman of the Board of Directors of Baden Technologies Inc., is pleased to announce that its subsidiary FSI International Services Ltd. has been awarded two significant contracts.

The first contract is with an existing Russian client for the provision of Brine Plant refurbishment and upgrades to existing FSI International Brine Plants installed in West Siberia. The total contract is valued at approximately \$1 million and will be completed within six months. FSI International is entering a new phase in the normal life cycle of its existing Brine Plants, and is seeing increased demand for refurbishment parts and services resulting from continuous operation of the plants. There are currently 19 FSI International Brine Plants in operation in West Siberia.

The second contract is with a domestic client, and is for the manufacture and supply of custom chemical blending skids. Total value of the contract is approximately \$500,000 and is scheduled for completion by the end of the third quarter.
